Mountain Biking

Tamarack Resort has the region's only <u>full-service bike park</u>, designed by experts of the International Mountain Biking Association (IMBA). The park features 27 miles of lift-served downhill and cross-country trails designed for all riding abilities, with access to endless miles of forest-service trails. Private downhill and cross-country lessons are available with the resort's PMBIA-certified instructors.

- 20 downhill single-track trails (**new** one-mile intermediate flow trail opening mid-summer)
- 18 single- and double-track cross-country trails
- Skills Park featuring multiple berms and tabletop jumps for all ages and skill levels
- Site of the NW Cup June 26-27—the best downhill bike series in the Pacific Northwest

Zipline Tours

The <u>Zipline Canopy Tours</u> start 1,800' above the valley floor and provide a bird's eye view of the surrounding peaks, forest and Lake Cascade. Guests zip along at speeds up to 30 miles an hour over creeks, canyons and the forest canopy while experiencing eight different ziplines, two suspension bridges and a 105' high treehouse.

Waterfront Cabana

Located at Lake Cascade's State Park Poison Creek Recreation unit, the <u>Waterfront Cabana</u> is the outfitter for Tamarack's watersports. Non-motorized rentals include kayaks, canoes and stand-up paddle boards, while the motorized fleet includes waverunners, pontoon and wake boats. Wakeboard, wake surf and water ski lessons are also available.

Guided River Tours

Tamarack's experienced professional river guides provide whitewater rafting adventures on the 11-mile Cabarton stretch of the Payette River. The full-day trips last seven hours and include roundtrip transportation and riverside lunch.

Axe Throwing

Located in The Village, the region's only outdoor <u>Axe Throwing</u> arena offers four lanes—each equipped with two targets—along with coaches to help hone your skills.

Hiking

Trail access from the end of Discovery Road leads to beautiful meadow and lake views. More advanced trails can be found from the top of the Tamarack Express. <u>Guided hikes</u> for all experience levels are available Saturdays and Sundays.

Disc Golf

Two separate <u>disc golf experiences</u> await guests—a nine-hole course wrapping around the base of the mountain and by mid-summer, an 18-hole course accessed from mid-mountain via the Tamarack Express chairlift.

Courts

Just steps from The Village are four <u>pickleball courts</u> and a basketball court, with pickleball sets available for guests at The Lodge at Osprey Meadows.
