TAMARACK RESORT TO OPEN NOVEMBER 27 WITH LIMITED OPERATIONS

Passholders, lodging guests & homeowners to get season preview

TAMARACK, Idaho (Nov. 23, 2020) — Tamarack Resort will open with limited terrain and services the weekend of November 27 – 29 from 9:00am-4:00pm for Boundless passholders, lodging guests and homeowners.

Reservations will be required to ensure social distancing on limited terrain. There will be two sessions on Friday for guests to access Discovery Chair terrain (9:00AM-12:30PM and 12:30PM-4:00PM). The resort will open the Summit Express terrain for skiing on Saturday and Sunday. There are a limited number of spots available for each day and they are certain to get snapped up quickly. Boundless passholders, lodging guests and homeowners can make reservations HERE for Friday and HERE for Saturday and Sunday.

What guests can expect:

- Be prepared to show your Boundless Pass (or proof of purchase) or your Lodging confirmation at ticket pickup. All tickets will be paper tickets and can be picked up outside the Sports Dome in Discovery Square on the day of your reservation.
 - Your ticket will only be valid during the reserved date and time.
 - All guests will be expected to adhere to our COVID Protocols.
- Limited food service
 - Tamarack's new restaurant The Reserve by reservation only
 - Mountain Bites Food Truck (outdoor seating)
 - Grab and go food from the Village Market and Clearwater Coffee
- No rentals or lessons available
- Downloading only on Tamarack Express (Saturday and Sunday)

<u>The Boundless Pass</u> and <u>The Express Card</u> for the 2020-2021 season are still on sale, and guests are encouraged to purchase these passes to guarantee access to the mountain as the sale of single-day lift tickets may be constrained to ensure shorter lines and uncrowded slopes (especially on weekends and holidays) for guests' safety and enjoyment.

Tamarack plans to open the full mountain to the public on December 11.
